



2008 LOS ANGELES COUNTY ARTS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

what: The Los Angeles County Arts Internship Program provides 10-week paid summer internships (40 hours/week) to eligible full-time undergraduate college students. Students are paid \$350/week to work in nonprofit literary, performing and presenting arts organizations and municipal arts agencies throughout Los Angeles County. Interns also participate in additional educational components provided by the Arts Commission (and supported by a grant from the Getty Foundation).

who: To be eligible to participate, students must meet the following criteria:

- Students must be currently enrolled (full-time) in a community college, four-year college or university program, and have completed at least one semester
- Students must be undergraduates and not scheduled to graduate before December of the year in which they participate.
- Interested students are not required to have demonstrated a previous commitment to the arts.
- Students **must either reside in Los Angeles County or attend school in Los Angeles County.**

when: This is a summer internship program. Interns will work for a specified ten-week period between June and August.

how: Students apply directly to the arts organization providing the internship. Participating organizations are listed in mid-March on the Los Angeles County Arts Commission web site at <http://www.lacountyarts.org/internship.html>
